

CONTRIBUTIONS (Voluntary)

The maximum amount of Contribution that can be asked for is \$60 (Education Act 1999 Section 99). The School Board has approved an amount of \$60 for 2020.

Money collected will be used in the areas listed below. The actual costs per child are shown in the table beneath. The quality of our teaching and learning will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of providing the range of programs at our school.

- Other activities available to selected students, but conditional upon payment being made eg Graduation Dinner etc.
